

## PROPOSED CUSTOMER NOTICE

Green Mountain Power (GMP) recently filed a request for a change in base rates to be reviewed by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (PUC). For October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027, GMP is requesting the PUC approve a 7.50% base rate change.

Base rates cover projected routine costs to serve customers with safe, reliable power. The proposed change in base rates this year reflects in part increases in regional energy markets and regional transmission costs as well as inflationary pressures. For an average residential customer using 550 kWh per month, this is about \$10 more a month. The PUC and Department of Public Service (DPS) will review this request over the coming months, with the DPS providing recommendations to the PUC by February 16, 2026.
