Dear Ms. Anderson:

In Green Mountain Power's (GMP) Quarterly Adjustor Report (Report) for the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2023 (FY2023 Q2) filed today in Case No. 23A-1409, GMP reported on the results for the Power Supply and Retail Revenue Adjustor (PSRRA) and the Exogenous Major Storm Adjustor (EMSA). As described in the Report, the current net adjustment results in the need to collect approximately \$19.496M beginning July 1, 2023, representing the previous \$6.344M Cumulative Carry Forward balance combined with the remaining \$13.152M from the ongoing adjustment approved by the Commission in March 2023 in Case No. 23-0334-TF.


To implement this adjustment, GMP submits the following:

- Clean and redlined record of filing tariff sheets, utilizing the line-item adjustor as approved by the Commission;
- The Line-Item Credit Calculation; and
- The Proposed Customer Notice

As reflected in these submissions and consistent with GMP's modified Multi-Year Regulation Plan approved in March 2023 in Case No. 23-0141-PET, the resulting 0.89% line-item collection will be applied to customer energy statements beginning July 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or modified by later approved quarterly adjustments.
