Re: Case No. 24-____-TF – Tariff filing of Green Mountain Power to revise the Power Supply and Retail Revenue Adjustor

Dear Ms. Anderson:

In Green Mountain Power's (GMP) Quarterly Adjustor Report (Report) for the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2024 (FY2024 Q1) filed today in Case No. 24A-0297, GMP reports on the quarterly results for the Power Supply and Retail Revenue Adjustor (PSRRA) and the Exogenous Major Storm Adjustor (EMSA). The results in the Report require that the \$10.73M Cumulative Carry Forward balance be combined with amounts already approved on customer energy statements¹ beginning April 1, 2024, through September 30, 2026, consistent with GMP's modified Multi-Year Regulation Plan approved in March 2023 in Case No. 23-0141-PET.

To implement this adjustment, GMP submits the following:


- Clean and redlined record of filing tariff sheets, utilizing the line-item adjustor as approved by the Commission;
- The Line-Item Credit Calculation; and
- The Proposed Customer Notice, which includes the Earnings Sharing Adjustor approved recently by the Commission.

As reflected in these submissions, the total line item adjustment will move from the current 2.43% to 3.39% and will be applied to customer energy statements beginning April 1, 2024 through September 30, 2026, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or modified by later approved quarterly adjustments.

¹ Specifically, this \$10.73M Cumulative Carry Forward will be added to \$43.75M from the ongoing adjustment approved by the Commission in September 2023 in Case No. 23-2589-TF and \$6.14M from the Earnings Sharing Adjustment Mechanism approved in January 2024 in Case No. 23-4083-TF.
